Most of our MS programs also offer 4-course **advanced certificates** that can be completed in **just 6 months**. They have been designed for experienced professionals who wish to upgrade or update their skills. Only those with either a master's or a bachelor's degree and two years related work experience are eligible to apply.

These 120-credit programs, offered in various business disciplines, provide students with the **skills, professional knowledge**, and **academic breadth** required to meet the challenges of today's workplace. Up to 75 credits may be eligible for transfer and, once admitted, students may challenge up to 12 additional credits for life-experience.

Bachelor's degree students at Manhattanville may be eligible to apply **up to 12 graduate credits** to both their undergraduate and graduate requirements by enrolling in one of our BS/MS dual degree programs.
